Major Duties and Responsibilities

Under the overall authority of Chief Executive Officer of the Network Activities Group, collaboration and guidance from the Program Manager, the direct supervision of the Project Coordinator (Pyapon, NAG), the incumbent will perform the following duties.

- Contributes to the development of policies and strategies of the emergency and non-emergency program activities in the fisheries sector
- Identify and select fishermen as per selection criteria, and form groups and select group leaders prepare training schedule and plan for fishery groups
- Designs, manages and implements projects related to the development of the Small Scale Fisheries and Aquaculture sector



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- Provides substantive technical input for developing aquaculture and small scale fisheries value addition related project proposals and provides scientific advice and conducts analyses in support of the fisheries activities for reporting
- Facilitate fishery group level training on aquaculture, nutrition and traditional practices issues
- Leading on surveying fish stocks, ensuring the correct type and amount of fish are in the right places
- Supports and carry out assessments, monitoring and evaluation methods, training and strategy with all relevant partners
- Working with project team members and carried out the regular field visits to provide intensive supports for fish farmers
- Communicating with and advising with fishery related stakeholders/ agencies of project
- Undertaking as focal liaising person on coordination and collaboration with peers and partner organizations including Local and International
- Improves dialogue with CSOs, NGOs/INGOs and other partners at field level, and liaises regularly with them as projects develop with the aim of improving implementation and activity performance and delivery
- Plans, organizes and facilitates training workshops and seminars; makes presentations on project topics and activities; prepares reports and other technical documents as required
- Supports in developing work plans and budgets, and in the monitoring and reporting of progress in Fisheries implementation (including financial reports) vis-à-vis agreed timetables and budgets
- Ensures timely dissemination of required information to the Project Coordinator/ Program Manager and all partners in support to the fisheries sector
- Prepares progress reports as well as a final technical report at the end of his/her assignment to be presented to the Project Coordinator/ Program manager
