*The project's goal is to improve social and economic status of rural households in a climate resilient manner in northern Magway region and southern Chin state. Its objective is to increase household incomes, food security and nutrition quality. Its investments focus on commodities and services that have comparative advantage, market demand and growth potential.*

## 1. Project Background

**WSAP** project is to provide social and technical support to related government departments and Myaing and Pauk township farmers and the landless on agricultural modernisation and rural transformation from 2019-2024. This project is the third investment of IFAD that creates the model for climate resilient agricultural transformation from subsistence to commercial livelihoods, across the western upland areas and forests.

The project's rationale has four dimensions: (i) to provide a systemic structural response to the challenges and opportunities for rural transformation in southern Chin and northern Magway; (ii) to create a model for the environmentally sustainable modernisation of agriculture in degraded sloping areas which generates economic benefits for poor households; (iii) to rehabilitate productive infrastructure in ways that maximise the sustainable use and output of the natural resource base; (iv)



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to forge pathways for communities to transition from subsistence to commercial livelihoods through access to inputs, knowledge and services. Elements of livelihoods support and nutrition-sensitive agriculture will be incorporated, to address important segments of local communities as appropriate.

## 2. The Role

Senior Community Mobilizers are the key on-the-ground players for project implementation. Supervised by the Team Leader, they will work closely with local communities for activities related to household incomes, food security and nutrition quality on agricultural modernisation and rural transformation.

## 3. Responsibilities

- Assist to supervisor when the preparations of field work plan and budget plan and other requirement.
- Mobilize to communities, association on overall project activities.
- Organize and strengthen group and association at the different level.
- Support and manage on community group and association for the improvement of household income and livelihood activities.
- Prepare and submit report to supervisor by monthly basic and ad hoc as require.
- Contribute in research, assessment and survey as data collection, entry and other assignment by supervisor.
- Support and course to the community when the preparation of multi-action plan.
- Monitoring and supervising to the community, activities to obtain the project expected goal and outcome.
- Assist to supervisor and officers on implementation of the project activities to get the progress.
- Support to extension service to the farmer and community through Knowledge Center to extend the technical.
- Follow on existing NAG policy and procedure and existing government policy, law of Myanmar.
- Perform additional tasks to meet the operational requirement.
