1. Background

MYFC aims to contribute to LIFT’s goal -sustainably reduce the number of people living in poverty and hunger and increase poor households’ resilience to income shocks- by increasing household income, food and nutrition security.

Although the project is intended especially for small scale aquaculture farmers, value chain should be considered as an important component part. In terms of value chain, the aspect of using ice box is an efficient way to maintain the quality of fish and increase market price.
