1. Project Background

The project is to build resilience of sesame and paddy farmers in two townships (Hpa-An and Hlaing Bwe) in Kayin State through empowering farmers to participate and benefit from the development of sesame and paddy crops value chain. The objective of the project will be achieved through establishing farmer development initiatives, increasing quality and productivity of sesame and paddy production, creating enabling environment for sesame and paddy farming and trading

2. The Role

Field Facilitators are the key on-the-ground players for project implementation. Supervised by the Project Manager, they will work mainly on sesame and paddy farmers for facilitation with the empowering farmers and value chain model.



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3. Responsibilities

- Strengthen and mobilize the community Base Organizations and communities' leaders
- Prepare, organize village level program activities and dissemination information to community members.
- Assist in action planning and detail work plan based on the project documents and log frame together with the team members
- Identify trainees and participants for the training, workshop, awareness sessions
- Identify suitable field demonstration plots and field study sites for cross learning
- Collect primary and secondary data for baseline, study and analysis
- Assist in administration, finance, procurement and logistics
- Assist in coordination with stakeholders including government department, partners, donors and private sectors
- Prepare field level report including field level M&E information, submit to Project Manager & M&E officer
- Dealing with township departments to participate in project activities implementation.
- Perform additional tasks to meet the operational requirement
- Any other duties as assigned by Project Manager

4. Requirements

The ideal candidate will have the following qualifications

- Bachelor degree and relevant experience
- Previous experience as facilitator conducting similar community development projects
- Atleast 2 years' experience in community development and resource governance
- Experience in community mobilization/organizing using participatory methods
- Strong familiarity with participatory development approaches
- Ability to work effectively in a multi-cultural environment
- Understanding of team building skills, basic community organizing and facilitation skills
