1. Project Background

The Agriculture Livelihood Action for Delta and Dry Zone (ALLADZ) project is jointly implemented by Cordaid ICCO (Part of Cordaid), Network Activity Group, and Tun Yat Limited since 2022 to increase income for pulses farmers and farm laborers, through increased farm productivity, increased access to more stable markets, and establishment of income generating activities for women groups.

The project is required to conduct the end-line evaluation aimed to provide representative quantitive and qualitative information on the project-targeted area to be compared with the gender-sensitive baseline assessment findings.



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2. Objective of the Study

The overall objective of the end-line evaluation is to measure the relevance, effectiveness, efficiency, impact, and sustainability of the project's intervention for learning.

3. Scope of Work

The consultant shall work closely with the NAG program team and PQL team for developing survey design, methodology, interview questionnaires, and work plan and providing the technical training to the survey team.

The consultant shall be responsible for leading the data collection and producing the quality report. The consultant shall be under the direct supervision of the PQL Manager.

The study values representation of targeted groups, villages, township, and region. The project covers 10 townships, 207 villages, and 10,770 beneficiaries in Yangon, Ayeyarwady, and Magway regions. Targeted groups include smallholder farmers, farm laborers, 54 women groups, 2 Regional Farmer Development Associations (RFDAs), 7 Township Farmer Development Associations (TFDAs), and 163 village/ community leaders.

4. Approaches and Methodologies

The consultant shall consider research methods (Qualitative, Quantative, or Mixed), data collection methods (Survey, FGD, KI, IDI), sampling producers (representation of township, villages, and beneficiaries), sample size determination, and reporting structure under the approaches and methodologies.

Qualitative and quantitative data is required to respond to the research objective that needs to be addressed under this study in the context of the project's targeted areas.

5. Consultancy Management

The consultancy will be managed by the Program Manager and involve consultation with the Partner Organization.

6. Time/timing

The consultancy should commence on 15^{th} November 2023 and should come out with a draft report by 15^{th} December 2023.
